ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
LIGHT ON YOGA ASSOCIATION

FIRST: The name of this corporation shall be Light on Yoga Association.

SECOND: The purposes for which this corporation is formed are:

A. The specific and primary purposes are to promote religious, charitable, scientific, literary, and educational activities as follows:

1. To promote Yogic education and impart Yoga instructions for the development of and integration of human personality in all its aspects, physical, mental and spiritual in accordance with the techniques evolved and developed by B.K.S. Iyengar.

2. To initiate aspiring individuals in Yoga irrespective of caste, colour, sex, religion and nationality.

3. To initiate, encourage, and guide in the works of methodology and techniques.

4. To print and aid in the writing of publications of books, articles, magazines and journals connected with the subject of Yoga.

5. To do all acts and things necessary to achieve the objects mentioned above either alone or in conjunction with any other person or institution.

6. To establish a library of Yoga literature

7. To make films either in black and white or colour on Yoga Asanas, Pranayama and Meditation with or without sound and distribute the same for exhibiting in schools and colleges, educational institution and elsewhere and/or making television films for education and propagation of Yoga.

8. To train teachers and instructors in the science and art of yoga,

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conduct tests and award certificates of merit to the successful candidates.

9. To revive interest in the teachings of ethical and spiritual philosophy of India.

10. To invite scholars, philosophers, and others to give lectures on Yoga.

11. To grant scholarships, or give monetary and/or other assistance, to students studying yoga.

12. To give donations or contribute to any other public charitable institutions.

13. To foster and develop correct meditative practice and to make comparative study in the meditative practices of East and West.

14. To enter into agreements with other public charitable institutions conducting yoga classes in conjunction with others and for the propagation of the aims and objects of the corporation.

B. The general purposes and powers are to have and exercise all rights and powers conferred on non-profit Corporations under the laws of California, including the power to contract, rent, buy or sell personal or real property, provided, however, that this Corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activity or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the primary purposes of this Corporation.

C. No substantial part of the activities of this Corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign including the publishing and distribution of statements, on behalf of any candidate for public office.

THIRD: This Corporation is organized pursuant to the General Non-profit Corporation Law of the State of California. This Corporation does not

contemplate pecuniary gain or profit to the members thereof and it is organized for non-profit purposes.

FOURTH: The principal office for the transaction of business of this Corporation is located in the County of Santa Clara, State of California.

FIFTH: The persons who are to act in the capacity as Directors of this Corporation shall be designated trustees. The names and addresses of the persons who are appointed to act in the capacity of trustees until the election of their successors are:

SIXTH: The authorized number and qualifications of members of the Corporation, the different classes of membership, if any, the property, voting and other rights and privileges of members, and their liability to dues and assessments and the method of collection thereof, shall be as set forth in the By-laws.


SEVENTH: The property, assets, and net income of this Corporation are irrevocably dedicated to religious, charitable, scientific, literary, and educational purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501 (C) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code and Section 23701 (D) of the Revenue and Taxation Code of the State of California, and no part of the profits or net income of this Corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any trustee, director, officer, or member thereof. Upon the dissolution and winding up of this Corporation, its assets remaining after payment of, or provision for payment of, all debts and liabilities, shall be distributed to a non-profit fund, foundation, association, or corporation, or other organization which is organized and operated exclusively for educational and scientific purposes, and which has established its tax status

under Section 501 (C) (3) under the Internal Revenue Code and Section 23701 (D) of the Revenue and Taxation Code of the State of California.

If this Corporation holds any assets in trust such assets shall, on dissolution, be disposed of in such manner as may be directed by decree of the Superior Court of the county in which is located the principal office of the Corporation on petition by the Attorney General or any person concerned in the liquidation thereof.

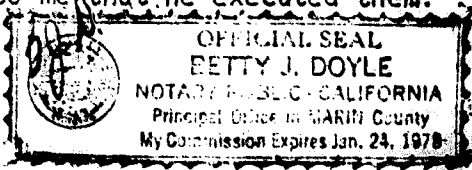

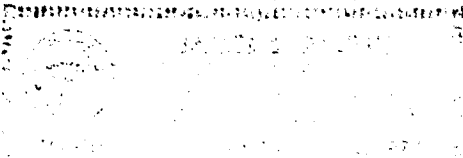

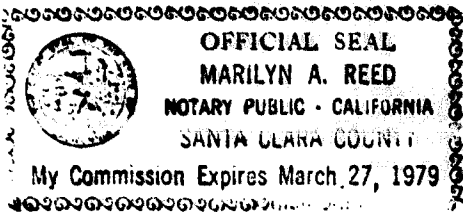
